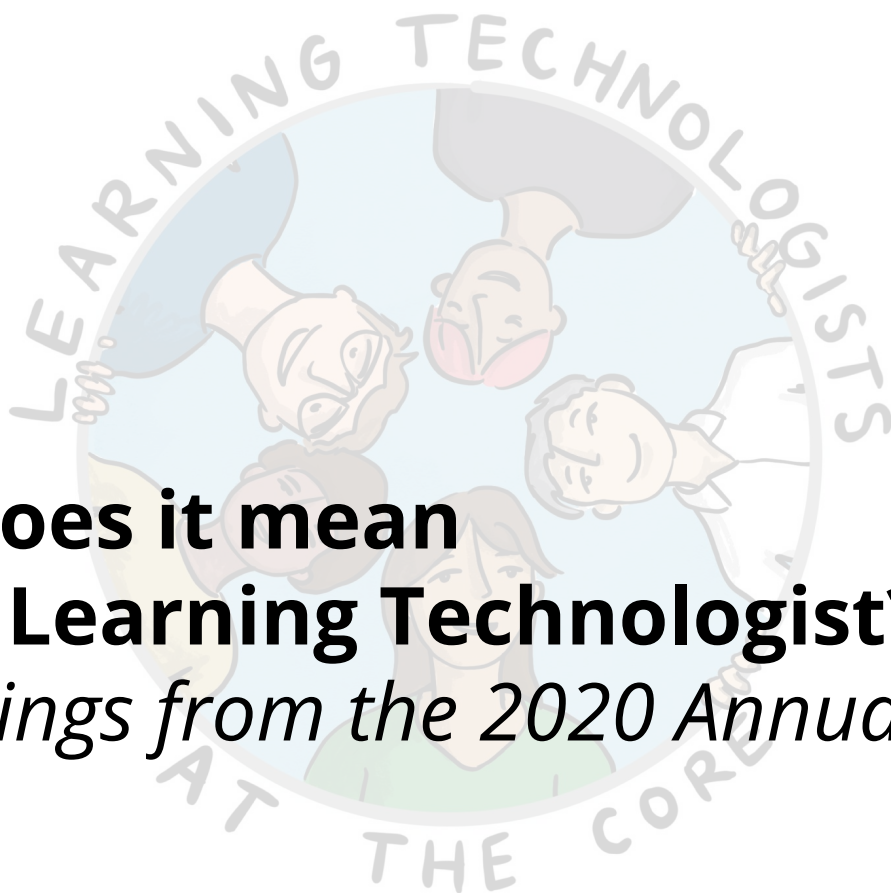

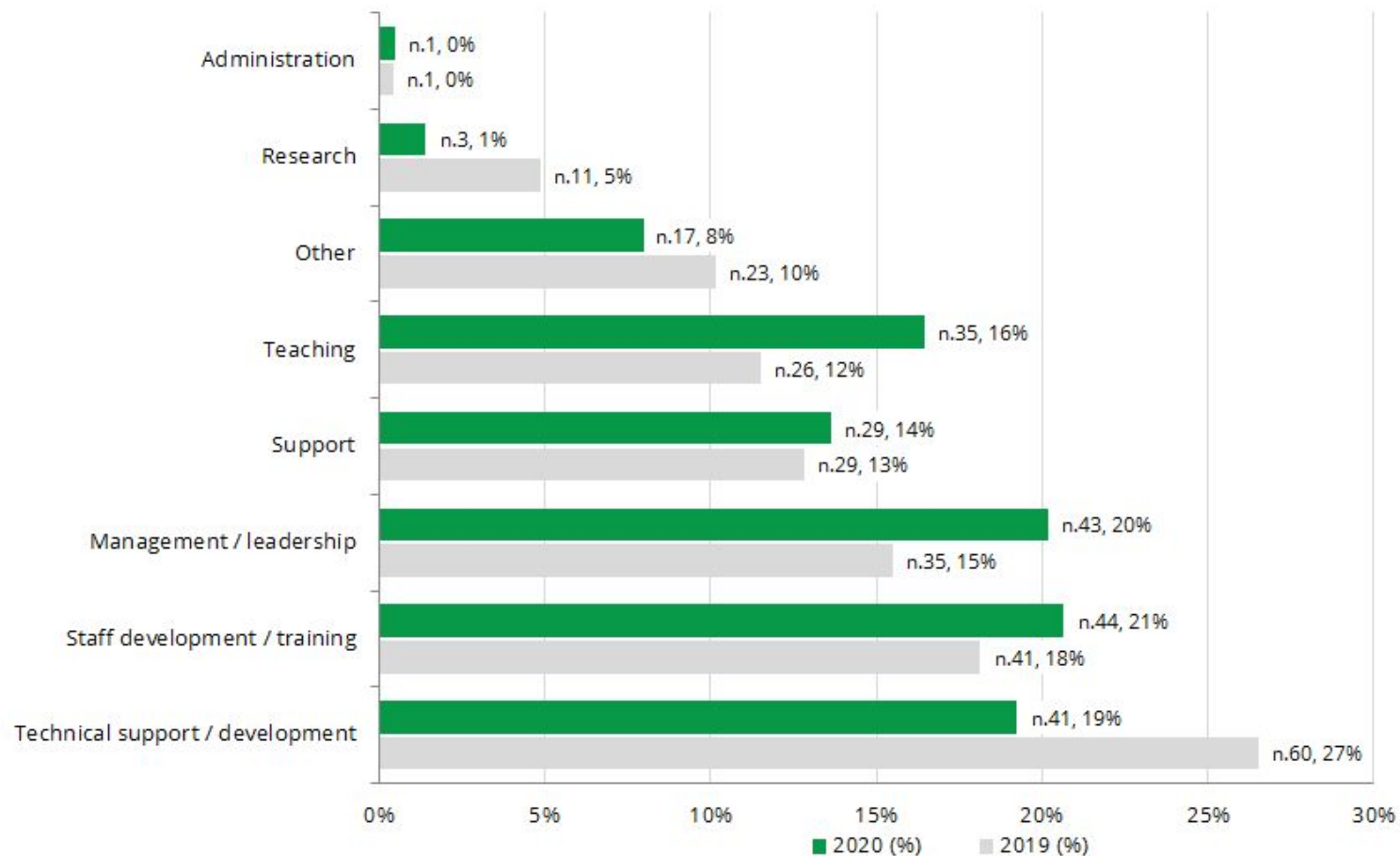

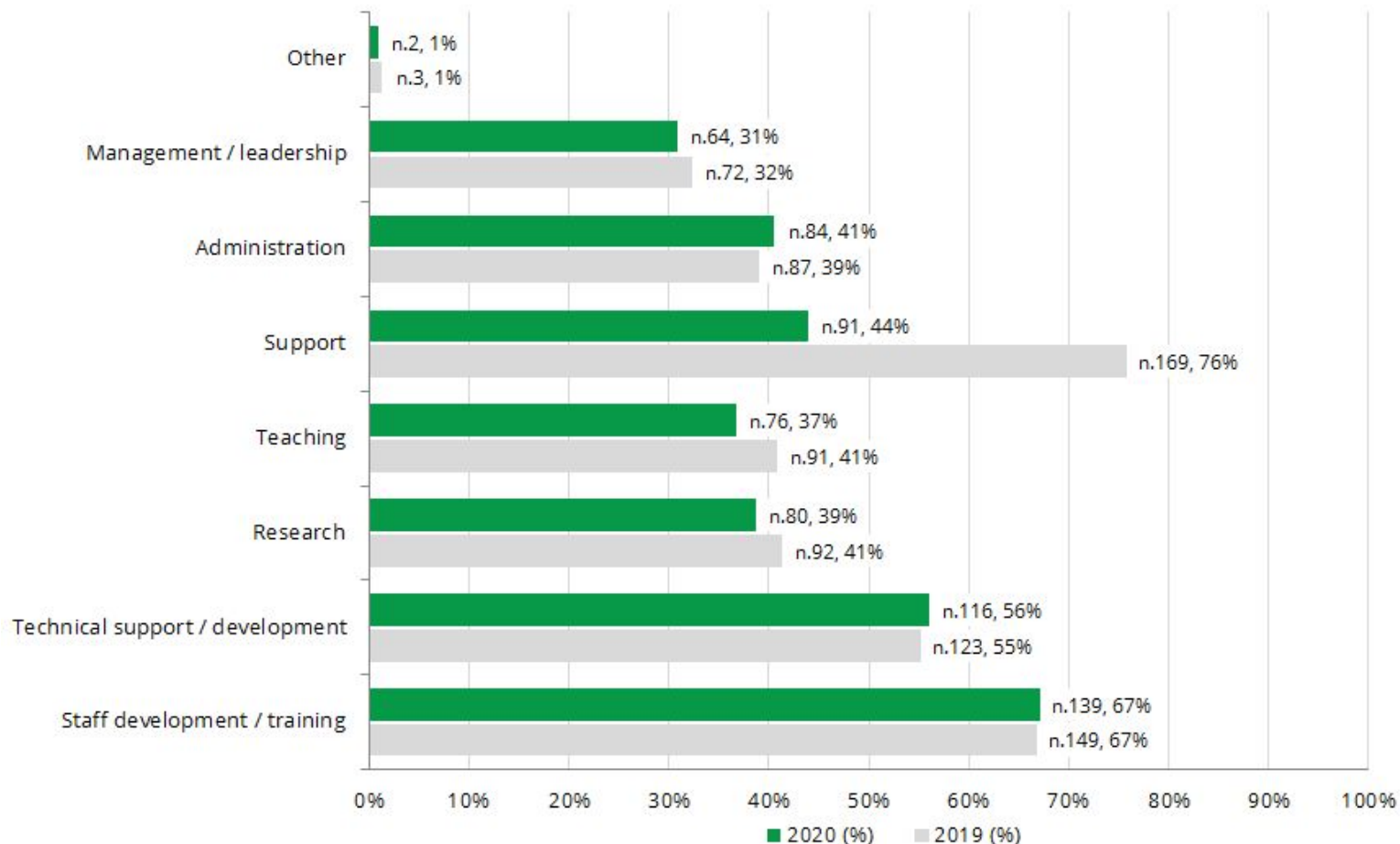

16. What is the primary function of your role?

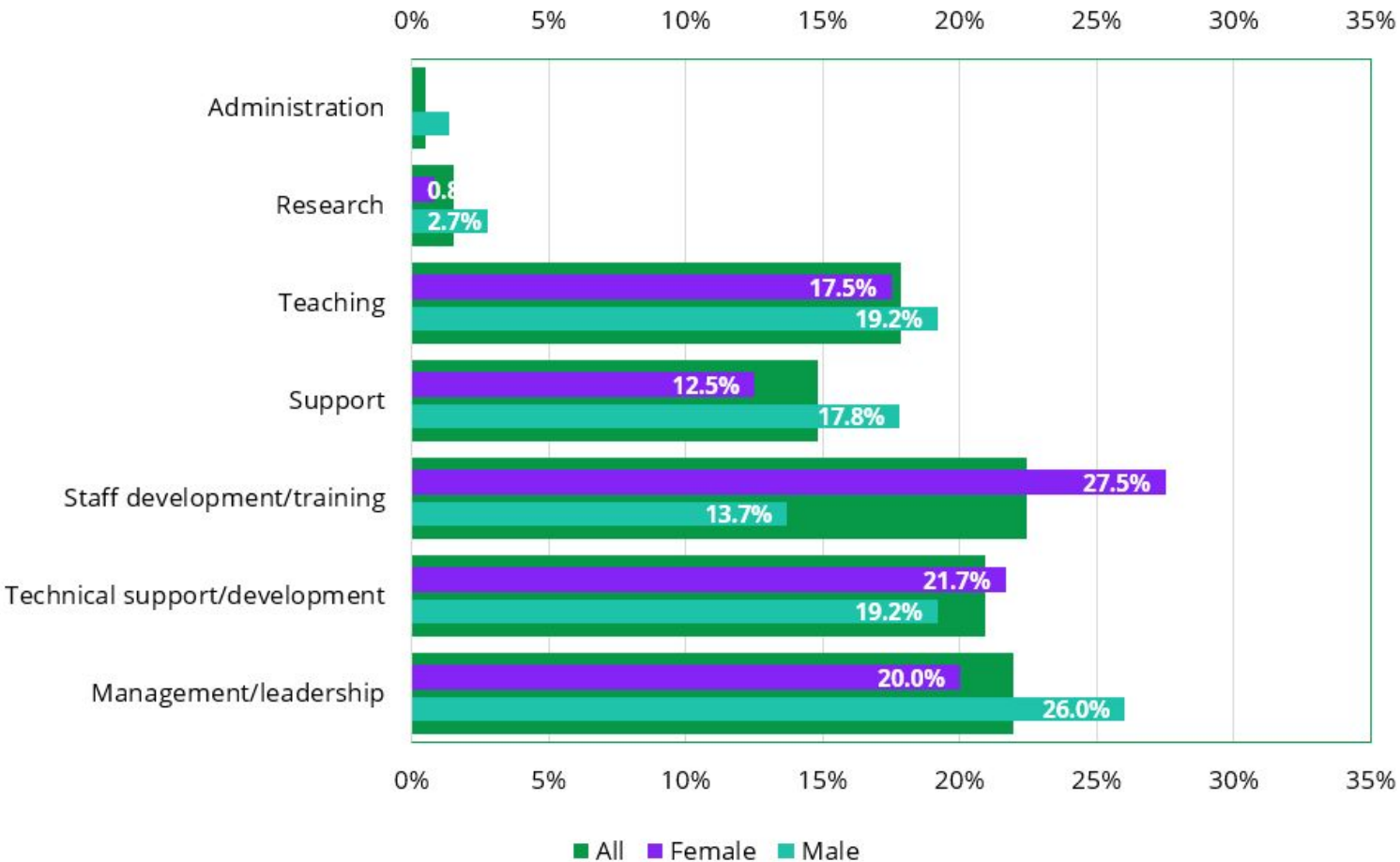


17. What are other functions of your role?

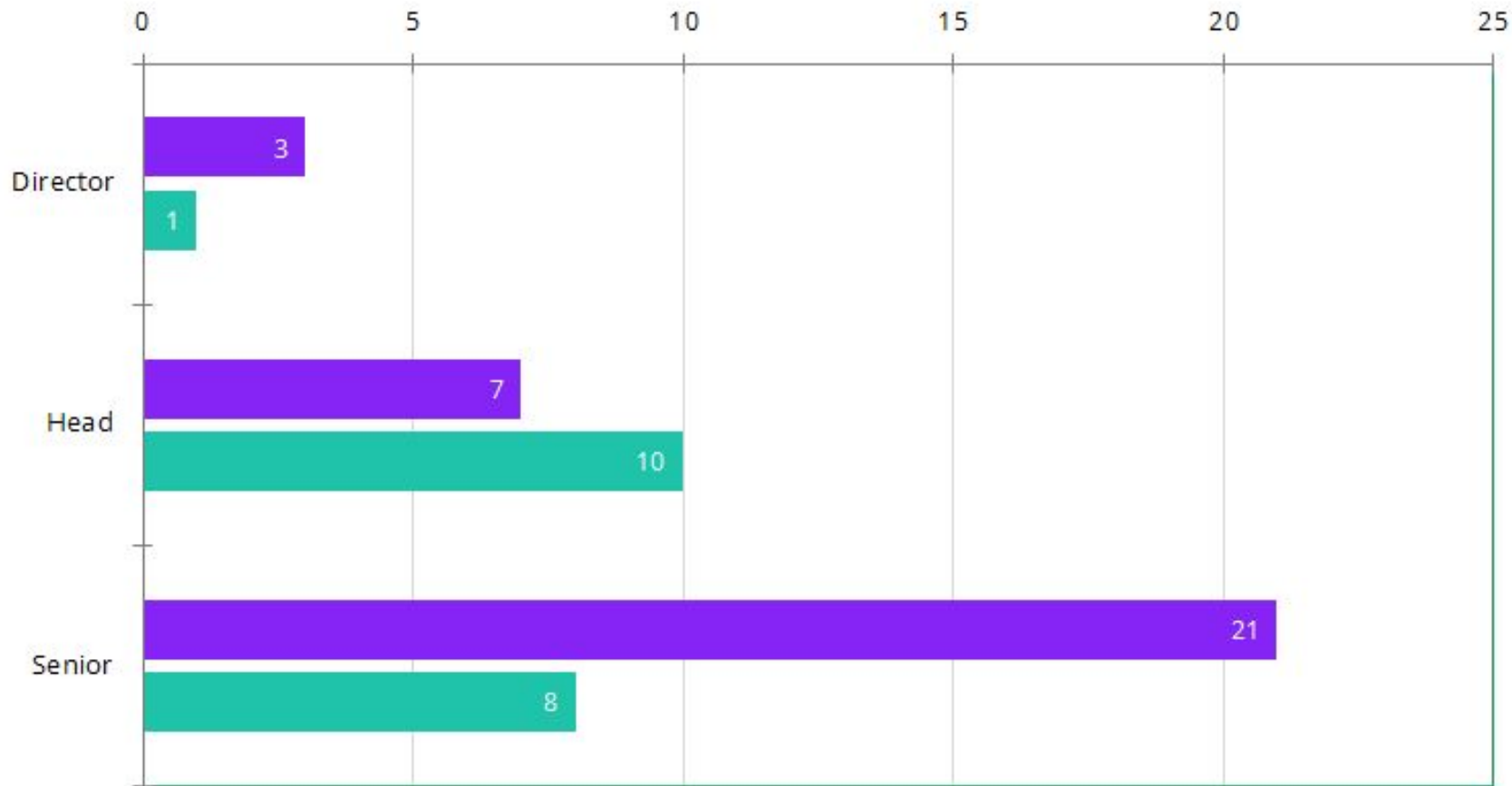

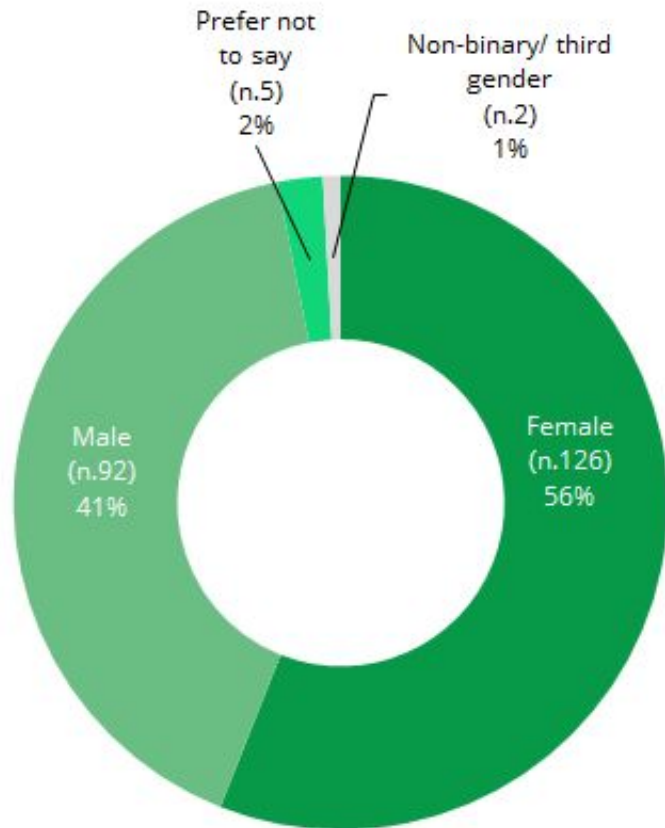
What is the primary function of your role? (2020)



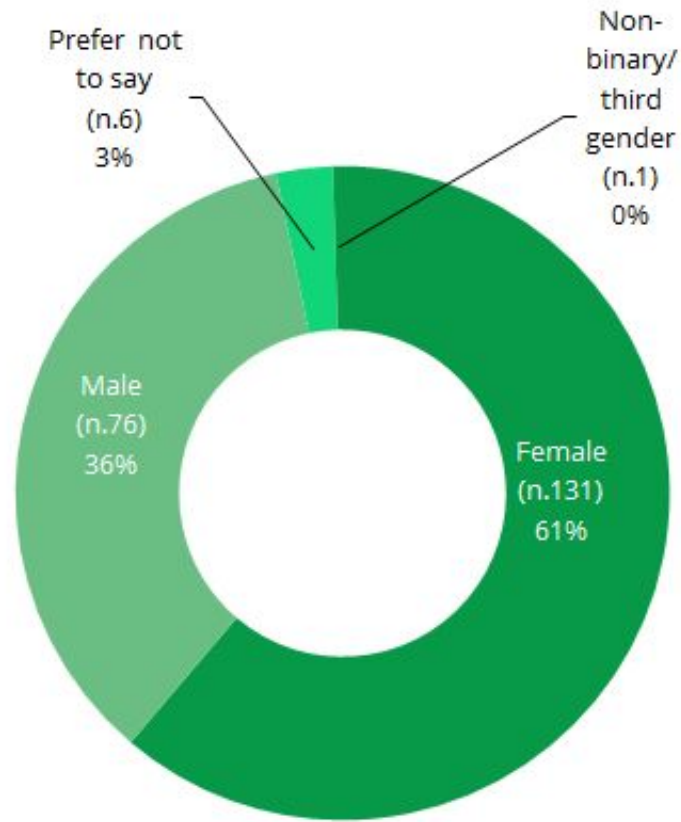
Job titles with 'Senior', 'Head' or 'Director' (2020)

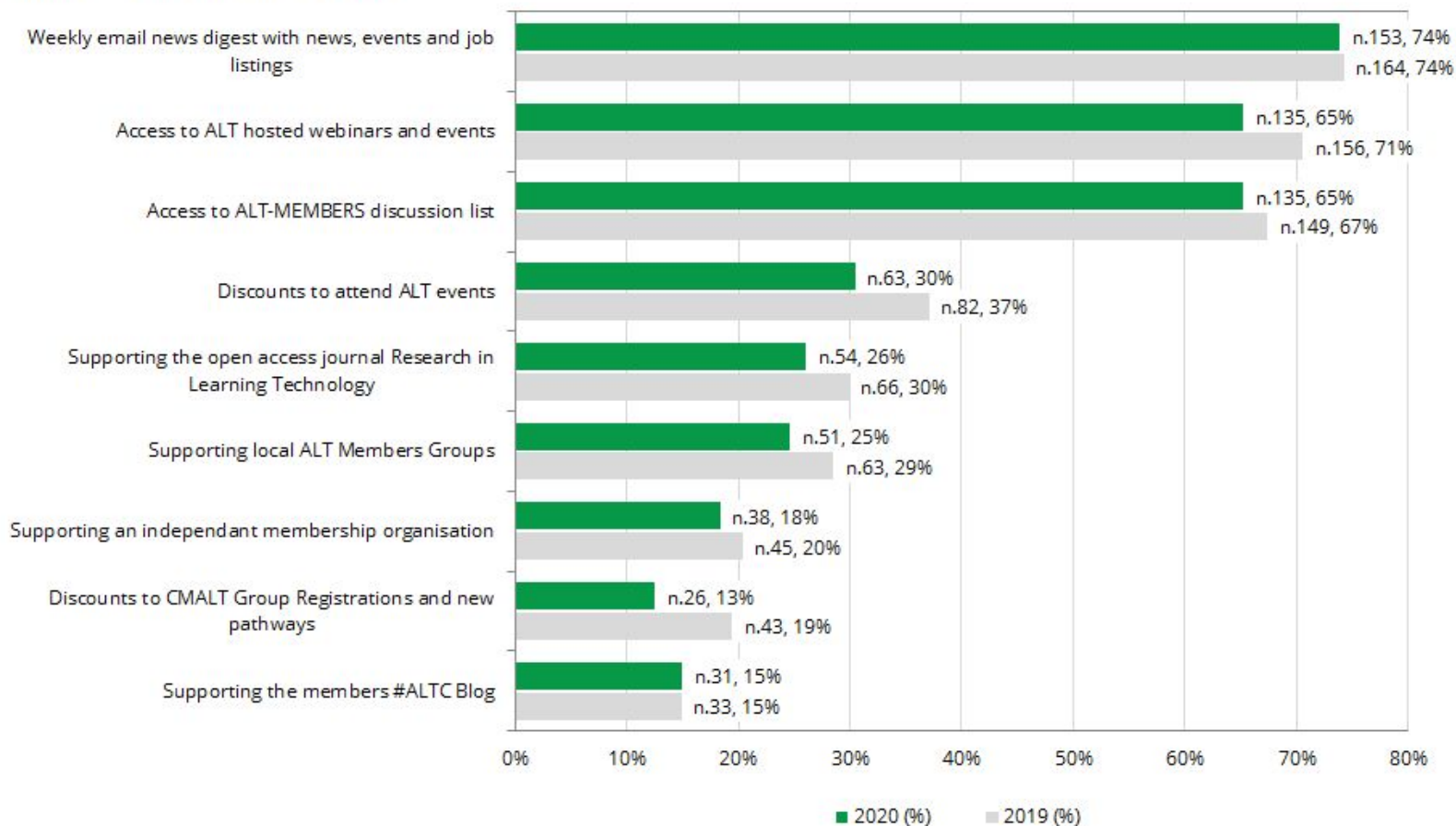

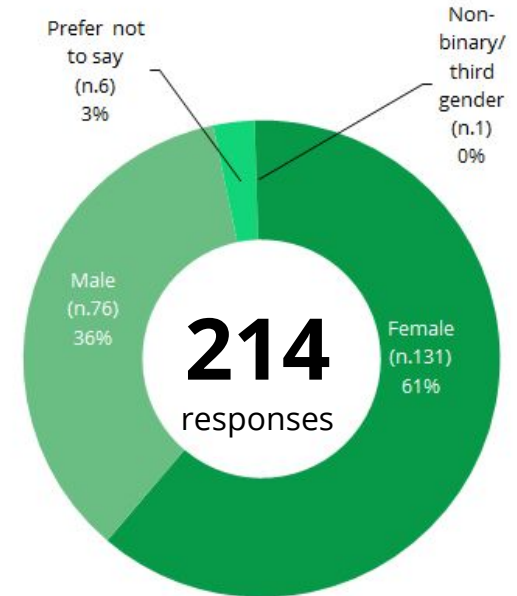
About the Survey
